a landmark in the conversation about race and religion in america they put him to death by hanging him on a tree acts 10 39 the cross and the lynching tree are the two most emotionally charged symbols in the history of the african american community in this powerful new work theologian james h cone explores these symbols and their interconnection in the history and souls of black folk both the cross and the lynching tree represent the worst in human beings and at the same time a thirst for life that refuses to let the worst determine our final meaning while the lynching tree symbolized white power and black death the cross symbolizes divine power and black life god overcoming the power of sin and death for african americans the image of jesus hung on a tree to die powerfully grounded their faith that god was with them even in the suffering of the lynching era in a work that spans social history theology and cultural studies cone explores the message of the spirituals and the power of the blues the passion and of emmet till and the engaged vision of martin luther king jr he invokes the spirits of billie holliday and langston hughes fannie lou hamer and ida b well and the witness of black artists writers preachers and fighters for justice and he remembers the victims especially the 5 000 who perished during the lynching period through their witness he contemplates the greatest challenge of any christian theology to explain how life can be made meaningful in the face of death and injustice

night in 1911 zachariah walker was lynched burned alive by an angry mob on the outskirts of coatesville a prosperous pennsylvania steel town at the time of his very public murder walker an african american millworker was under arrest for the shooting and killing of a respected local police officer investigated by the naacp the horrific incident garnered national and international attention despite this scrutiny a conspiracy of silence shrouded the events and the accused men and boys were found not guilty at trial more than 100 years after the lynching authors dennis b downey and raymond m hyser bring new insight to events that rocked a community
